Group Payment

For pre-booked groups of 10 or more, we offer a 10% discount on entry. This discount is only available if the group pays as a whole. If individuals are paying separately, the standard entry fee will apply per person.

We kindly request payment on the day of your visit. Accepted methods include cash, card, or cheque made payable to Live Borders Ltd.

Alternatively, we are able to invoice your organisation following the visit, provided that full billing details are submitted in advance.

Group Catering Policy

All pre-booked catering requirements, including any dietary needs, must be confirmed at the time of booking or no later than seven days prior to your visit.

Please note that only food and beverages purchased within the centre may be consumed on the premises.

Equipment Usage and Safety

A range of equipment is available as part of our room hire options. Please contact us in advance to discuss your specific requirements.

All equipment must be used in a safe and responsible manner. Users are expected to follow any instructions provided by staff and to report any faults or issues immediately. The Great Tapestry of Scotland reserves the right to withhold equipment use if safety guidelines are not observed.

Modifications and Cancellations

Requests to modify or cancel a booking must be submitted no later than 14 calendar days prior to the scheduled visit date.

Catering orders may be amended or cancelled up to 7 calendar days in advance. After this deadline, catering charges are non-refundable.
